- Twelve schools earned the U.S. Department of Education’s highest honor, the Blue Ribbon designation.
- Deep Run and Godwin High Schools received a silver medal ranking and were named as “Best High Schools in America” by *U.S. News & World Report* in 2009. Henrico High School was named one of *Newsweek* magazine’s Top 1500 High Schools in 2009.
- Included in the Best 100 Communities for Music Education in America, HCPS is the only school division in the nation to earn this designation ten years consecutively.
- Thirteen Henrico schools earned the 2010 Governor’s Award for Educational Excellence and 20 schools earned the 2010 Board of Education’s VIP awards.
- Received the coveted ACE (Award for Continuing Excellence) from the U.S. Senate Productivity and Quality Award (SPQA).
- One of the first school districts in the nation to implement a one-to-one laptop computer initiative in middle and high schools and received the National School Boards Association’s Trailblazer Award and the Virginia Governor’s Technology Gold Award.
